## Section2. SOSCRepresentatives

SOSCrepresentatives reelected by the members and shall consist of eleven representatives representatives.

Only representativeshall bevoting members of the SOSC Alternates may vote in a representative absence The SOSC yearruns from June 1 to May 31. Representatives shall be elected to terms as ting two years.

## Section3. Alternates

Alternatesshall consist of the two non-elected candidates with the most votes in the most recentelection. Alternatess hall be held to the same attendance requirements representatives and may contribute to debate at meetings but may only make motions and vote when filling in for an absent representative.

In the eventa representative sets vacated the alternate from the campus with the most votes in the most recentelections hall fill the seat. If an alternate fills a representative seat, the nominee with the next highest number of votes in the most recentelection will fill the alternate seat. If no alternates available, the SOSC presidents hall decide to hold a special election, or to appoint amember to complete the current year.
