## 2. Options include:

- a. Providing a suspension time limit. Example: a 5-year suspension would require a review and at that time a decision would be made whether to delete or restart the program.
- b. Limiting suspensions that need approval e.g. one or two year suspensions do not need board approval.
- c. President reviews proposed program suspensions.
- d. The VPAAR could write a memo to the Board to notify them of the proposed program suspension.
- e. Suspensions are eliminated so that it goes straight to the Board as a deletion.
