 - a. UAA MSDietetics and Nutrition

UAA has an accredited bachelors of Science in dietetics degree and graduate certificate. The professional accrediting body has mandated that by 2024 for standard licensure. This Masters of Science will build from the existing Bachelors and Graduate Certificate programs.
